Ask yourself these questions:

1. Do I have a Will?
2. Do I know where it is?
3. How old is it?
4. Do I remember what it says?
5. Have my personal or financial circumstances changed since the date of my Will?
6. Are the beneficiaries of my Will still the beneficiaries of my choice?
7. Does my Will take into consideration the personal and financial circumstances of my beneficiaries?
8. Who is the Executor of my Will?
9. Is that Executor still the person of my choice?
10. Is my Executor aware that they are the Executor of my Will?
11. Does my Executor know where my Will is kept?
12. Can I foresee any problems arising from my affairs on my death?
13. Do I have a Power of Attorney?
14. Is it an enduring Power of Attorney?
15. Do I need to make a legally recognised appointment for someone to take care of my personal welfare when I am unable to do so?
16. What about my partner? (Have them go through this list too!)
